

Frequent + Consistent



High-Quality Instructional Materials (HQIM)

SOWING THE SEEDS | THE SCIENCE

Tutoring Comparison

Traditional Tutoring	Misbranded HIT	High-Impact Tutoring
Homework help focus	May claim data-driven but not consistent	Data-driven + consistent feedback loop
Lack of systematic curriculum	Inconsistent tutor quality	High tutor training standards
Limited data tracking	Marketing focus on "high-impact" but lacks evidence	Evidence-based curriculum
Offers 1:1 or small group sessions	May use some advanced tech tools	Focus on building relationships

Best Practices + Evaluation



Frequent + Consistent

- » At least 2–3 sessions per week
- » At least 30 minutes per session
- » At least 12 week cycle



High-Quality Materials

- » Aligned to standards
- » Based on research

- » Impact measurement



Relationships

- » Well-trained, consistent tutors
- » 1:1 or small group
