

HIT = High Impact Tutoring

01	Frequent + Consistent	At least 2–3 sessions per week, 30 minutes each.
02	Relationships	Well trained, consistent tutors. One-on-one, face-to-face, or small group.
03	High-Quality Instructional Materials	Proven effective lessons rooted in research- backed design and supporting standards.
04	Data and Progress Monitoring	Informed instruction and impact measurement of the program.





PLAN YOUR SUMMER PROGRAM

What to consider

Determine your Summer Program Scope:

- » How many weeks does the Summer Program run?
- » How many days per week?
- » How many students anticipated for the Summer Program?

Evaluate Program Options:

- » How many days per week will students receive tutoring? (recommended 3–5, 30-minute sessions/week)
- » How will students be grouped? (1:1, 1:2, 1:3, and/or 1:4)
- » Where will students receive tutoring? (recommended at school)

Building Summer Success

PLAN YOUR SUMMER PROGRAM

What to consider

Tech Readiness Considerations:

- » Student Access to 1:1 devices
- Student access to strong internet connection
- Students may need headphones with microphones to reduce background noise

Staffing Needs:

- » Who is facilitating the summer program?
- » Who will support with student log-in during session?
 - How many will you need (typically under 1:30 ratio per session)
